- Dr. Miller is great. The way he approaches the class is great and I really enjoy the moments where the class really debates issues that the readings bring up.
- More early-mid semester engagement with the final paper, helping each student create a good thesis/research question base to alleviate later double-guessing
- This course content just does not lend itself well to a discussion format as it stands. While interest groups can be an interesting prompt for discussion, it's too easy to get bogged down in the details of the studies we read and can feel more like a course on reading and interpreting articles and understanding study design than on interest groups. It can also be hard to get through reading the articles for this course because they're usually not particularly intriguing and downright esoteric at times.
